How to Use

Degrease surfaces thoroughly. Apply a drop of **Vortex VC313** to one of the surfaces to be bonded. Assemble immediately, light contact pressure is needed to prevent movement and minimise bond gap. Cure can be achieved within 10 seconds in most cases.

Storage

Store products out of sunlight in original container. Do not mix used product with unused product. The expected shelf life is at least 6 months stored at room temperatures between 5 and 25°C. If stored at 0 to 5°C shelf life can be increased to 12 months+.

Health and Safety

Bonds skin and eyes in seconds. In the event of bonded skin soak with water and gently peel apart with a blunt object. Avoid prolonged contact with skin especially if sensitive, bruised or lacerated. Wash splashes of adhesive off skin with soap and water. Eyes should be protected from inadvertent splashes. In case of eye contact flush immediately with water and seek medical attention. If large amounts of adhesive are spilled onto certain materials such as paper or cotton very rapid curing takes place.

Contaminated clothing should therefore be removed as soon as possible to avoid possible burns to skin.
